Introduction: Paul is in the process of closing his letter to the Romans.

- 1. Paul is trying to tie off all the lose ends in his communication with the Romans.
- 2. It's as if his mind is going in several directions at once.
- 3. He has just challenged them to remember who they are in Christ & laid out his vision for ministry.
- 4. He wants them to succeed, to be the church God intended them to be.
- 5. As he works toward the close of this letter, he urges them to do two specific things that are absolutely essential to that success.
- 6. These practices were important in Paul's day & they still are today.
- I. Successful Churches Are Praying Churches
 - A. The Reality of Spiritual Warfare
 - B. The Power of Prayer
- II. Successful Churches Are Careful Churches
 - A. Separation From Evil
 - B. Dependence on God

Conclusion: Do you see what Paul is saying? It is easy for us to be quite comfortable in our faith.
