Introduction: It's taken a while, but we have come to our final study in Micah, and it's a good one.

1. Here Micah reminds us of who God is & what God is like. That is important.
2. Many people have faulty perceptions of God.
3. Those perceptions function as obstacles preventing a healthy relationship with God.
4. Here's the question: How can those people ever experience the life God offers?
5. Life to its full, lives of meaning, purpose, & significance are rooted in knowing God.
 - The One Who Created Everything
 - The One Who Controls History As "His Story"
6. Today we will focus on God. As you understand who He is, what He's like, what He offers, my prayer is you will commit your life to Him.
