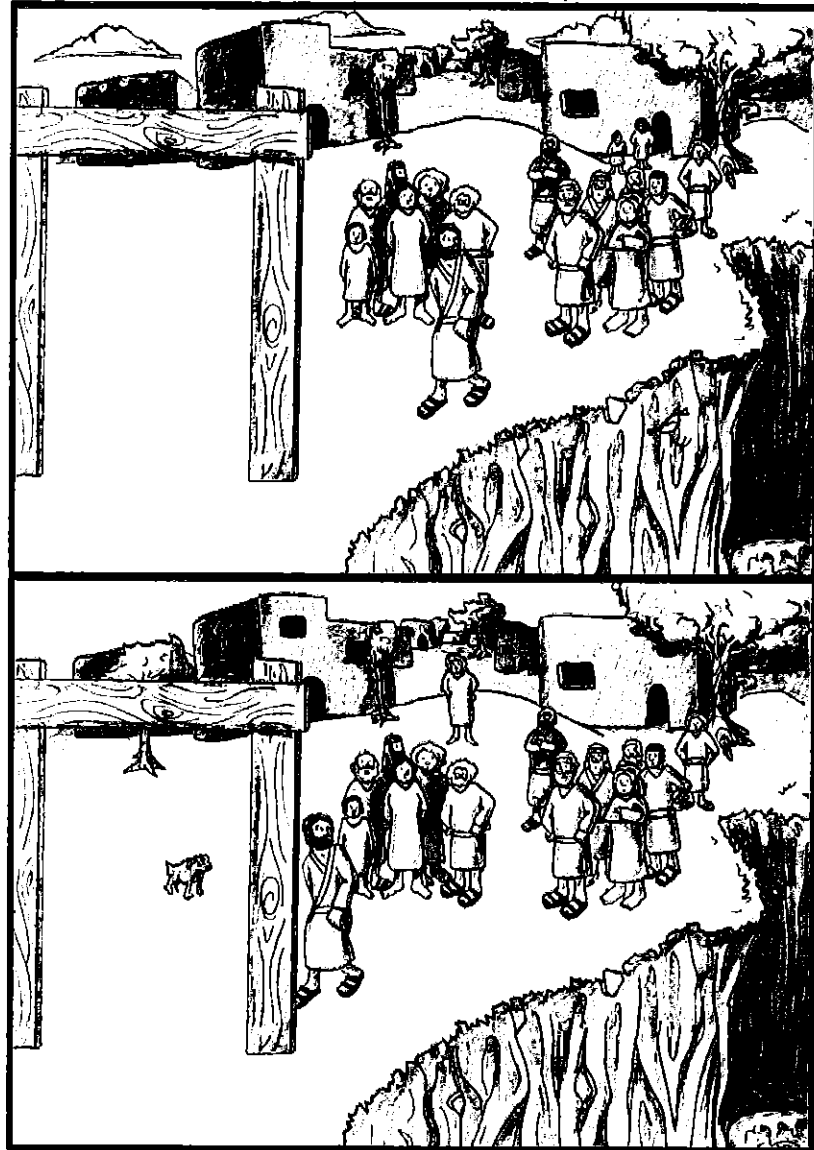
 In each row, **X** the one that does not belong.



Jesus said that no prophet was respected in his own town.

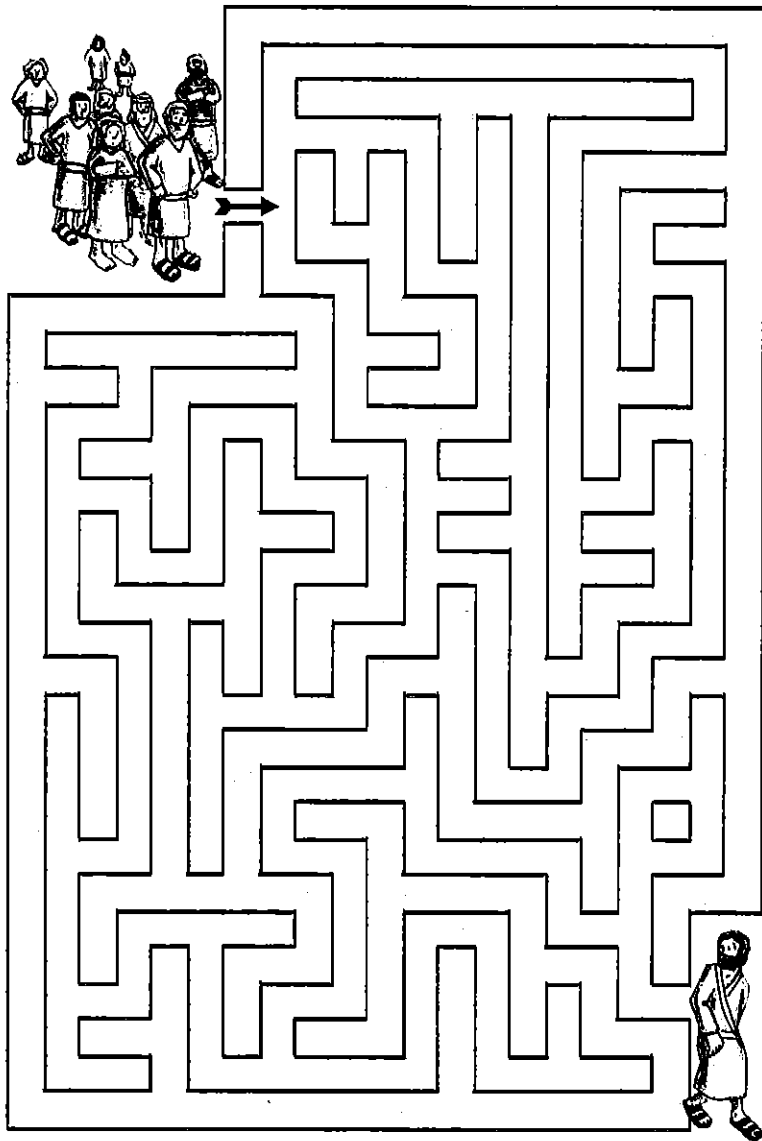

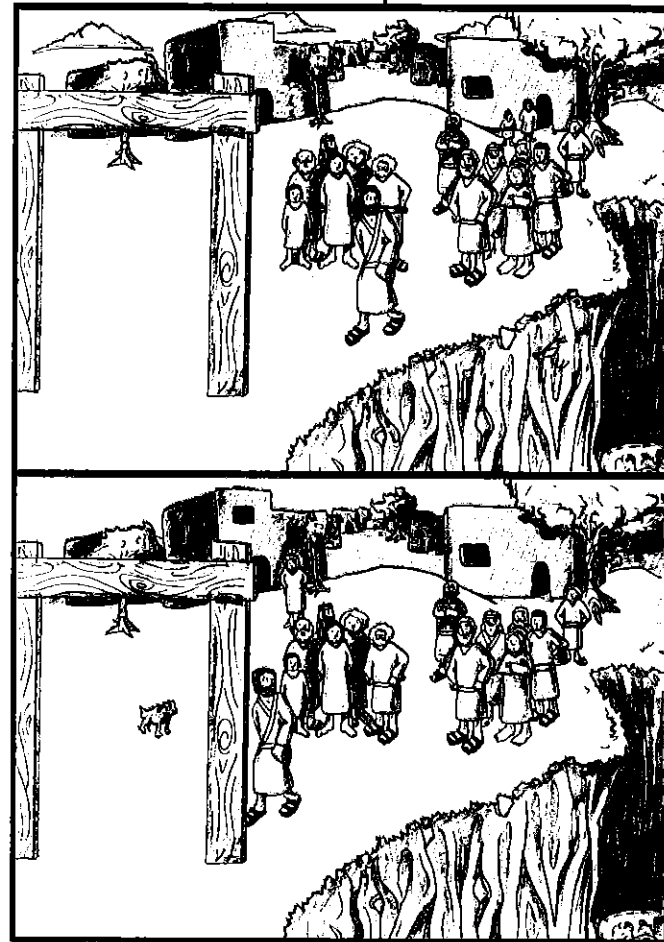
