Introduction: We have begun a new series where we are working our way through the book of Esther.

- 1. Esther is a historical narrative that fleshes out some of the most important elements of our faith.
  - The Sovereignty of God
  - His Providential Care For His People
  - His Omniscience & Omnipotence
- 2. As we started last week, we noted how God was setting the stage for the rest of the story by controlling the affairs in the Persian royal court.
- 3. This morning as we come to chapter 2, we see how He advances His plan.
- 4. The invisible threat at this time is Haman & a law that would effectively lead to a Jewish genocide in the Persian Empire.
- 5. To address this looming threat, God will do two remarkable things:
  - Elevate Esther to be Queen
  - Elevate Mordecai as a Hero
- 6. Because of God's work here in chapter 2, Israel will be saved when the threat becomes visible.

Conclusion: What's interesting here is Mordecai is not recognized or rewarded as a hero at this point in the narrative.
