Finding Freedom: A Study In Galatians "Theology Matters" Galatians 3:6-18

Introduction: We are working our way through Galatians where Paul is explaining how we can have freedom in Christ.

- 1. This letter was necessary because of the false teaching of the Judaizers.
 - The Judaizers were Jews who had embraced Christianity imperfectly.
 - They insisted you could not be acceptable to God without circumcision & keeping the law.
- 2. Paul understood the danger here. To supplement the gospel in this way is to supplant it.
 - That means, theology matters.
 - Distorting the gospel can have eternal consequence.
- 3. As we come to our text today, Paul continues to explain justification by faith alone in Christ.
- 4. As we understand this truth, we find greater freedom in Christ!
- I. Abraham: The Father Of Faith
 - A. The Issue: Who Is A Child Of Abraham?
 - B. The Theology:
 - Abraham's Righteousness Was By Faith
 - Abraham's Gospel Included The Gentiles
 - Those Who Believe (Faith) Are Abraham's Children

- II. The Law: Inadequate To Justify
 - A. The Law Condemns
 - B. Faith Cannot Be Annulled

Conclusion: This doesn't end the argument; Paul will continue the theological debate in chapter 4.

- 1. For our purposes, Paul's point is clear, theology matters.
- 2. Religious effort, morality, rituals, sacraments, whatever, cannot make us acceptable to God.
- 3. Ignoring this reality is frustrating & eternally risky.
- 4. Thankfully, in Christ everything that is necessary to be right with God has been accomplished.
- 5. God offers us salvation as a free gift. We simply need to receive it by faith.
- 6. Do you believe you are a sinner?
- 7. Do you believe Christ came & died to save you?
- 8. Why not invite Him into your life as Savior & Lord!
