"Slavery & Sonship" Galatians 3:19-4:7

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Introduction: We are working our way through Galatians where Paul explains how we can find freedom in Christ.

- 1. This explanation was necessary because Christianity was struggling with the relationship of law & grace.
- 2. Paul understood that adding conditions to grace, nullified grace.
- 3. Part of the problem in this debate was an inadequate understanding of the law.
- 4. In today's text, Paul explains the role the law played in God's plan.
- 5. It was never intended to be the final destination, more like a steppingstone to Christ.
- 6. This means we cannot be right with God outside of a faith relationship with Christ.
