## Finding Freedom: A Study In Galatians

"Liberty Or Legalism" Galatians 5:1-12

Introduction: We have spent several weeks working through Galatians. In today's text Paul shifts his focus.

- 1. Earlier he defended his apostleship, the gospel of grace, & made a doctrinal case for justification by faith in Christ alone!
- 2. Today we begin a more practical section that covers the rest of this letter.
- 3. Back in Galatians 1:4, Paul had introduced the freedom Christ offers; now he is able to elaborate.
- 4. The Judaizers' fear was that an emphasis on grace led to reckless living.
- 5. That is not what Christ intends or offers. He offers true righteousness as the Holy Spirit transforms us from the inside out!
- 6. When we understand & live this, we can experience the life God offers us in Christ.

  - A. Christ's Purpose (5:1)
  - B. The Galatian Error (5:7-12)
- II. Understand The Choices
  - A. Legalism
    - Christ's Work Nullified
    - Obligated To Keep Entire Law

- Severed From Grace/Christ
- B. Liberty
  - Faith
  - Holy Spirit
  - Righteousness

Conclusion: Paul closes this section with a clear statement.

- 1. In Christ, circumcision or a lack of circumcision have no bearing on our relationship with God (think religion here).
- What does matter is faith, but not just any faith, a working faith where the transforming work of the Holy Spirit systematically changes us from the inside out, so we live a life of love for God & neighbor.
- 3. When this is true, you are free & on the path to becoming the person God designed you to be!
