Introduction: As we come to scripture this morning, Paul is focused on the practical side of Christianity.

- 1. In Christ, the believer has been set free.
- 2. To the Judaizers, this was a scary proposition that would surely lead to reckless living.
- 3. Their answer was a continuation of the law.
- 4. This was a nonstarter with Paul because it negated the very freedom Christ died to secure.
- 5. He understood freedom in Christ was not an opportunity for the flesh, instead it offered the possibility of a Spirit filled life.
- 6. As we continue our study, we will focus on the Spirit filled life.

Conclusion: Notice how verse 23 ends, "Against such things there is no law."

- 1. The point being, such a law is unnecessary. Who would ever want to outlaw the fruits of the Spirit?
- 2. There is another reality Paul understands, there is no law that could produce these fruits.
- 3. The flesh needs law. The Spirit is an internal law.
- 4. When we crucify the flesh & yield to the Spirit, we are free to become all that God designed us to be.
- 5. Today, tomorrow & every day for the rest of our lives, we have a choice to make.
  - We can live a natural, fleshly life.
  - We can live a Spirit filled life.
