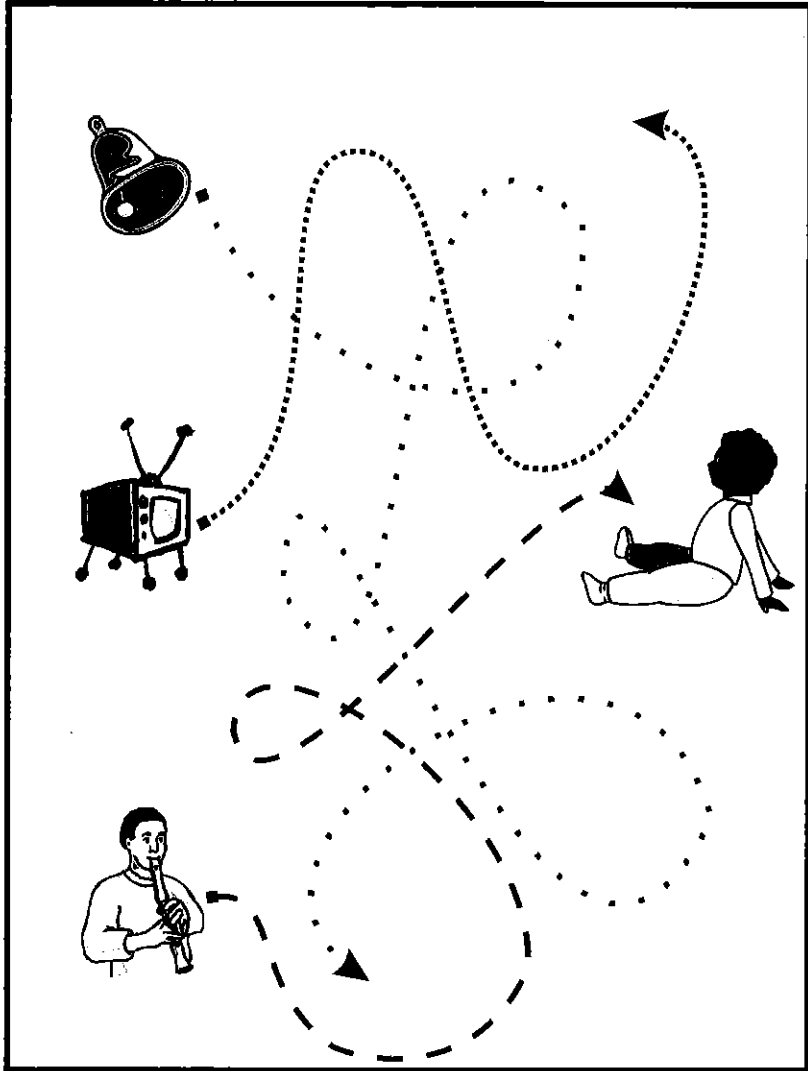


Find 5 stars in the picture.
