## Leaving A Legacy: A Study In 2 Timothy

Introduction: We have begun a study where we are working through 2 Timothy.

- 1. It is an extremely personal book, written just prior to Paul's death
  - As such, I believe Paul is focused on his legacy.
  - In many respects, Timothy represents Paul's legacy.
- 2. So, he writes to make sure his legacy will last, and the church of Jesus Christ would thrive.
- 3. He started his letter by reminding Timothy of God's work in his life.
- 4. Today, he applies what he shared by challenging Timothy to be courageous!
  - Where will the courage come from?
  - Obviously, that answer will be Jesus. But that means we must have confidence in Jesus. Do you?
- I. The Call To Confidence
  - A. Do Not Be Ashamed
  - B. Join Me In Suffering
- II. The Basis For Confidence
  - A. My Belief In Christ
  - B. Christ's Ability To Deliver

Conclusion: What's amazing here is when Paul pens these words, this is not the "best of times" in Paul's life.

- 1. No, he is about to be executed.
- 2. But his confidence in Christ had not drifted.
- 3. That's why he could be courageous in life and ministry.
- 4. He understood the same was true for Timothy and each one of us.
- 5. We need courage to serve Christ. That courage will come from Christ as we are confident in Him.
- 6. If you have that ... press on!
- 7. If not, remember when you trust Christ, He is able to deliver everything you will ever need.
