


CAN YOU GUESS WHO I AM?


Draw a line from the clue to the person it describes.







I was crying because I thought someone had moved Jesus' body, but then I heard Jesus say my name and saw Him standing before me! (John 20:1, 11-16)


spoke to some women and told them, "Do not be afraid; Jesus has risen from the dead!" (Matthew 28:5-6)

I said I would not believe that Jesus had risen from the dead until I could see and touch the nail prints in His hands and the place where the sword had pierced His side. (John 20:24-29)




Jesus asked me if I loved Him three times. In this way, He helped me to know that I was forgiven for denying that I knew Him three times before His death.
