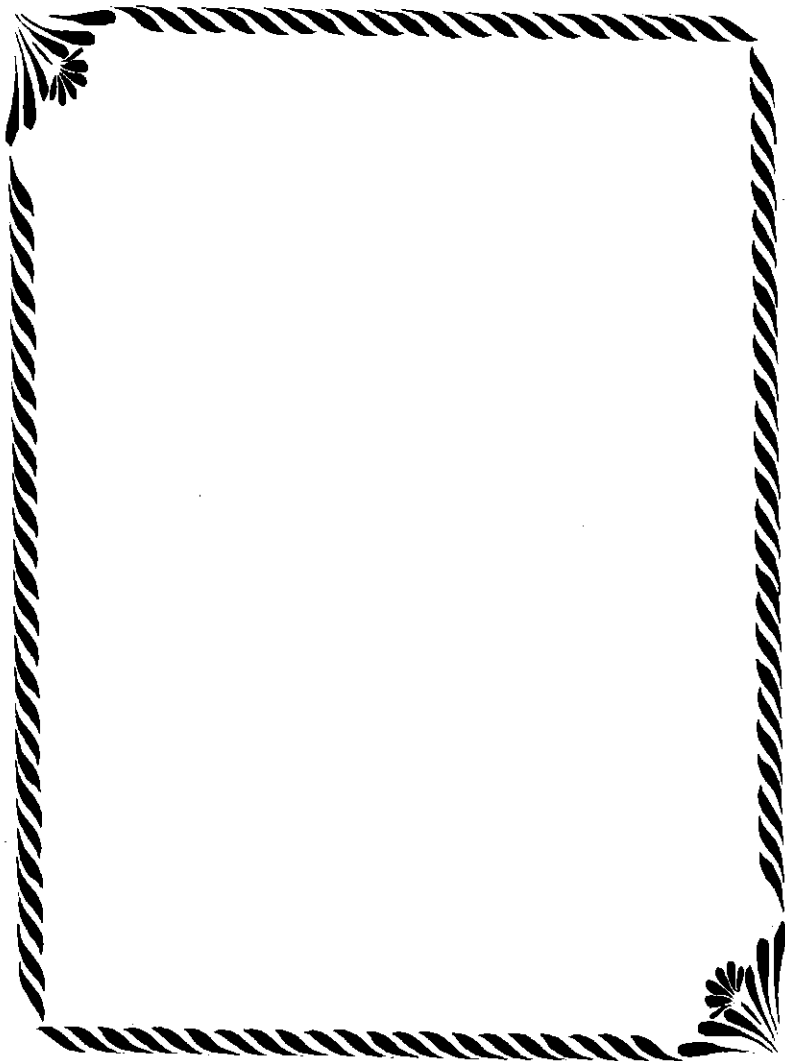

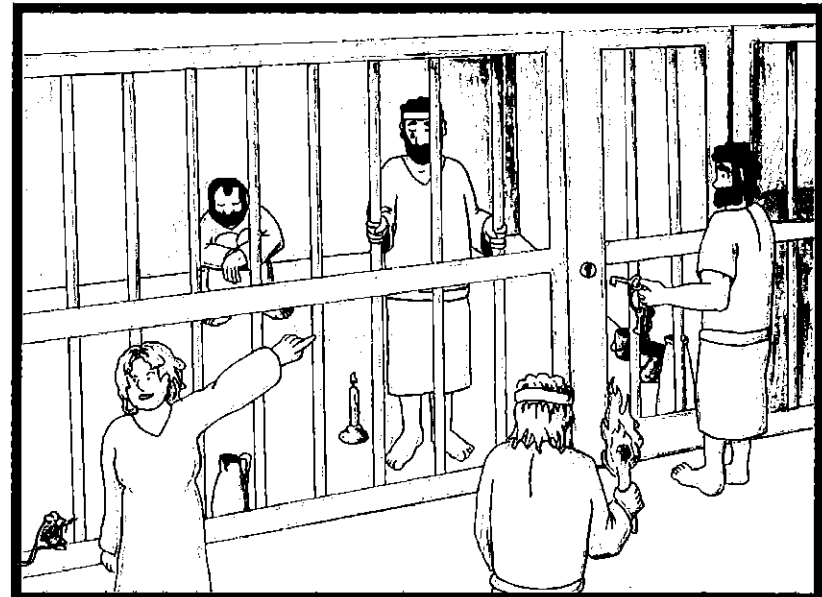

John the Baptist was jailed because the queen didn't like his preaching. Later King Herod had him killed.

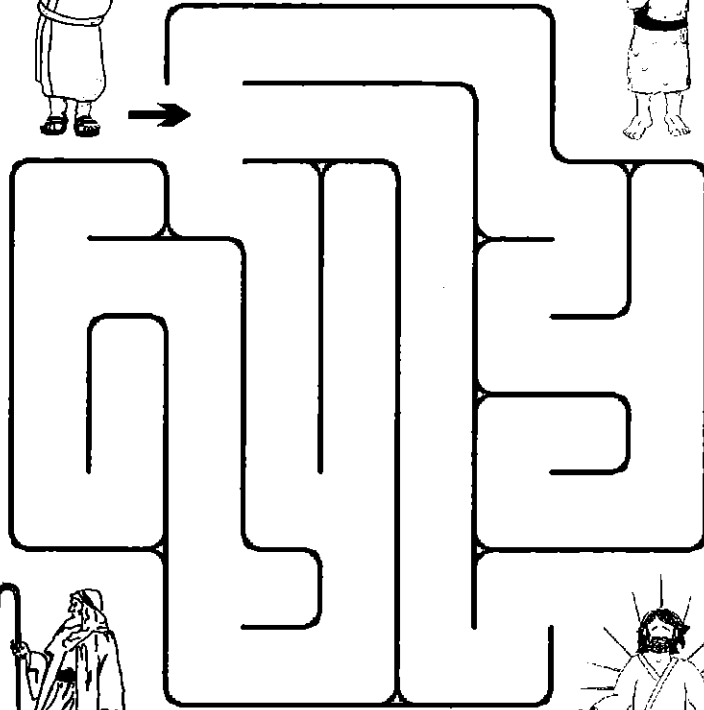

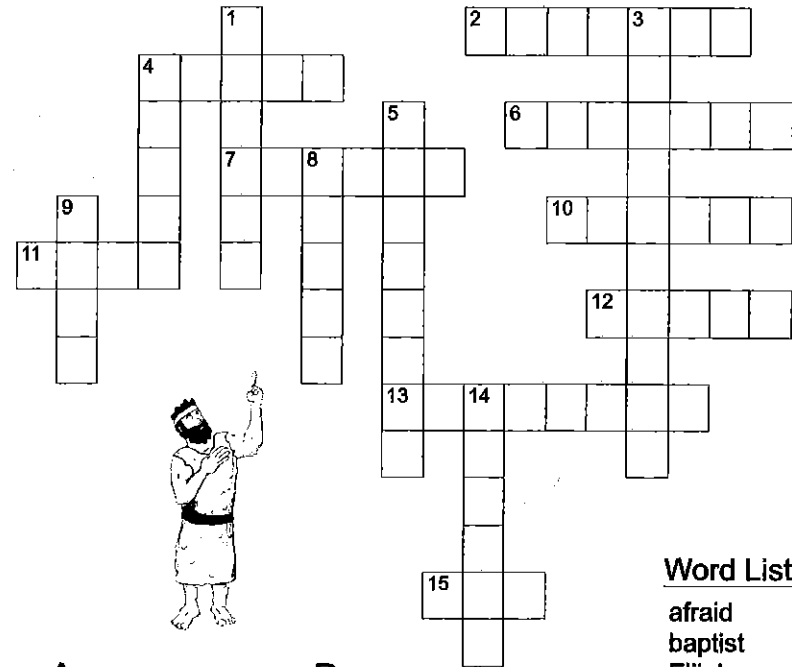
