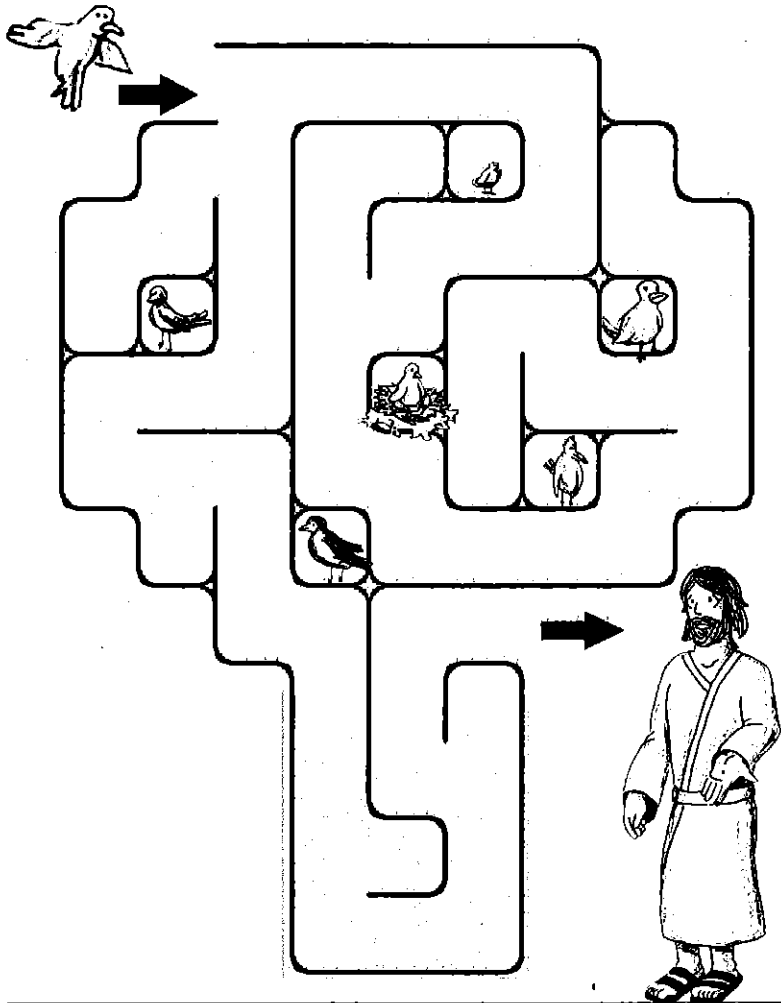

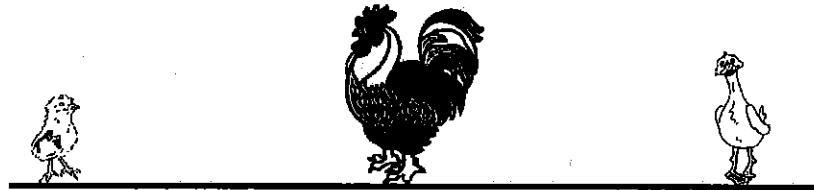
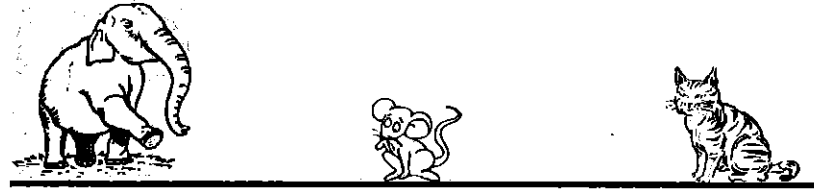

Circle the one in each row that is biggest.



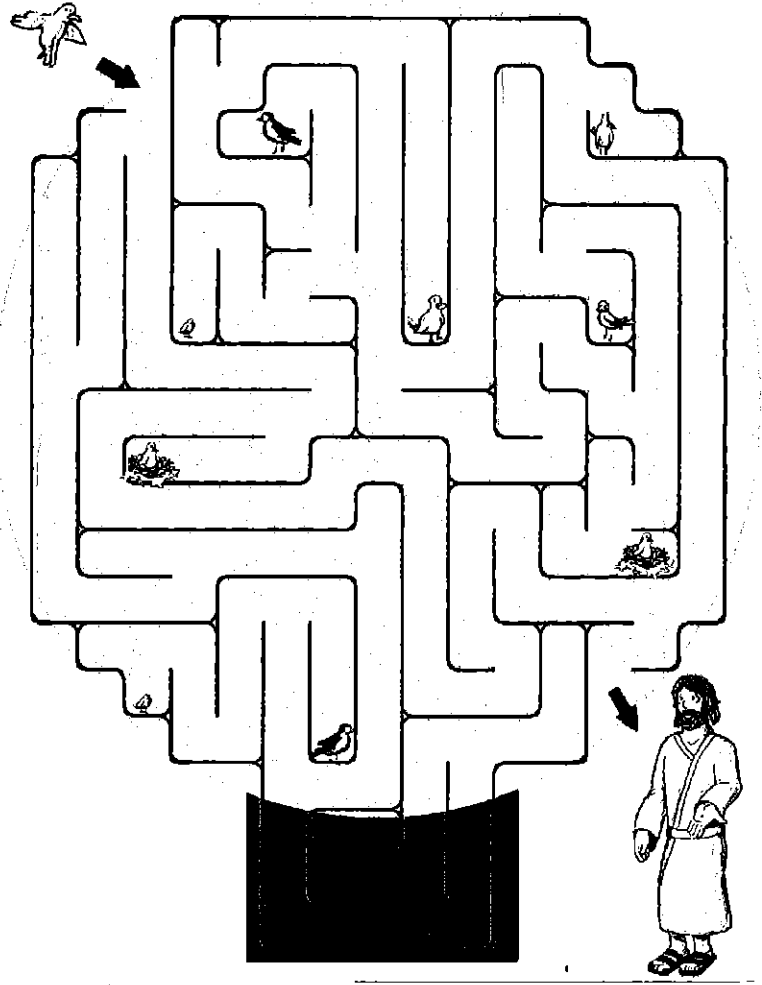
