Jesus helped the deaf man hear and talk.

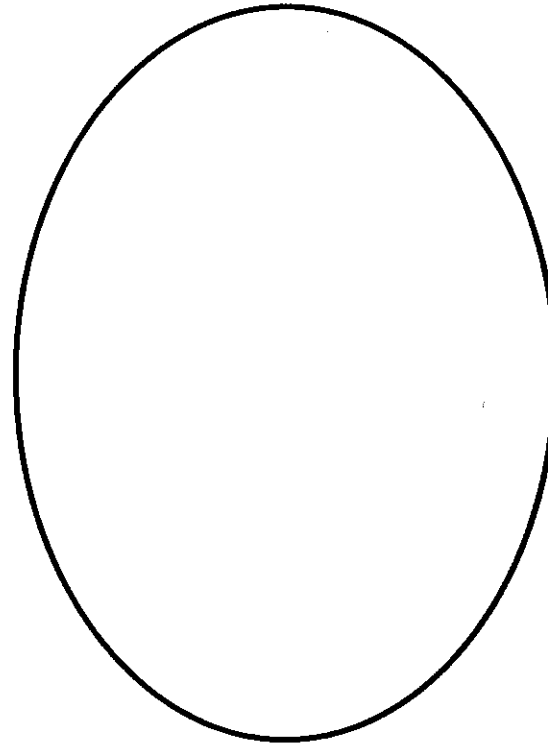
 Draw a line from the ear to things we can hear.

 Draw lines from the eyes, mouth, and nose to the things we can see, taste and smell.



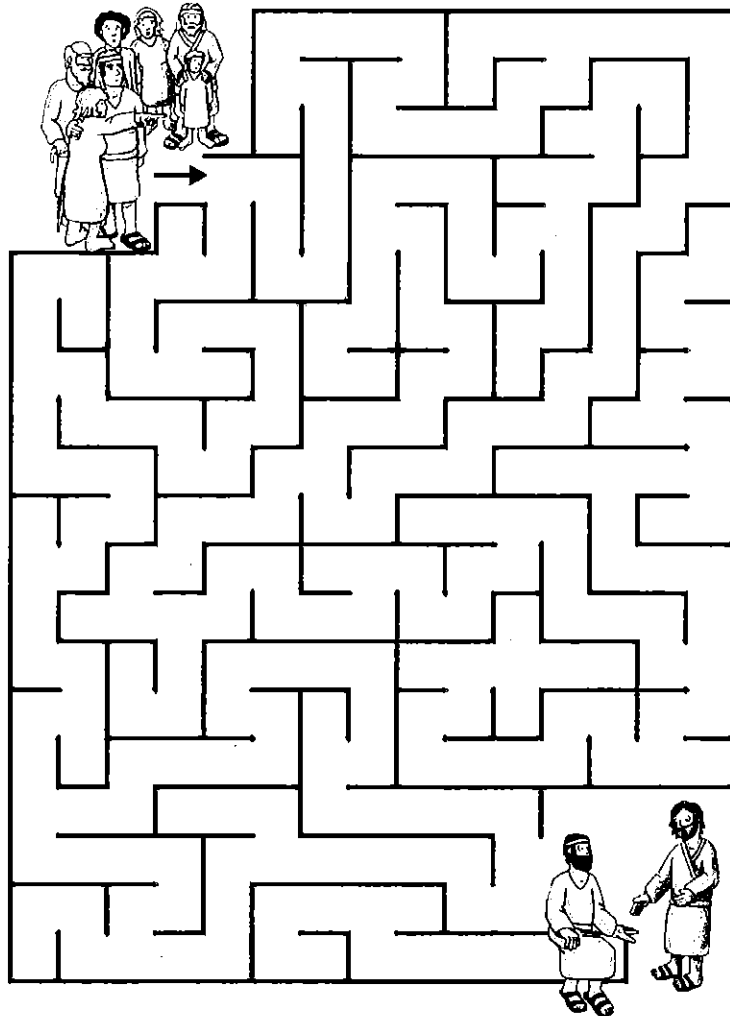
Draw your face.

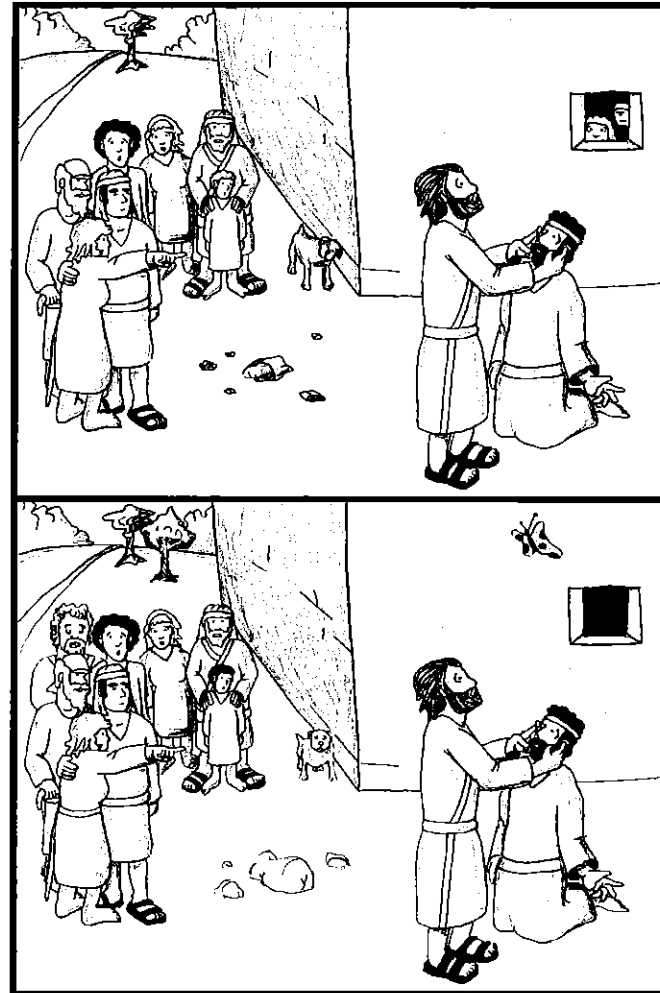
