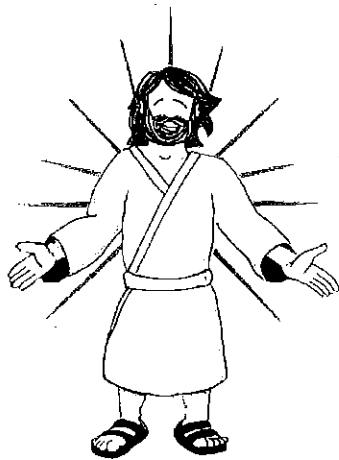

The bread and wine in communion remind us that Jesus died for us.

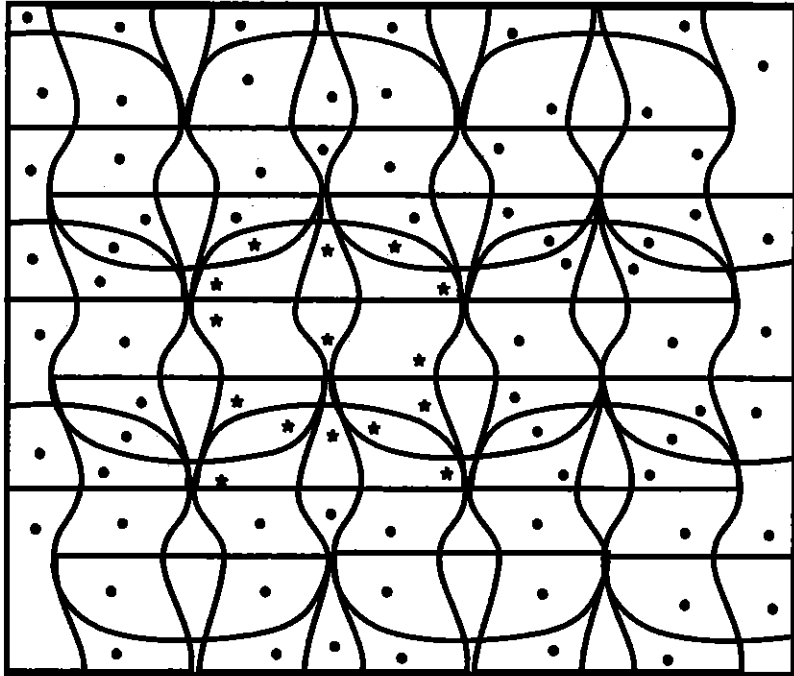
Circle the objects that begin with the letter **b**, as in the word bread.

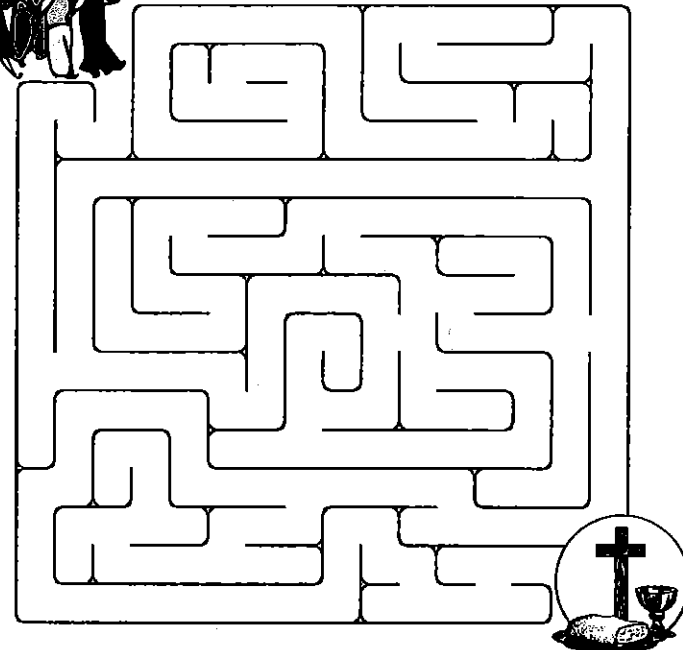

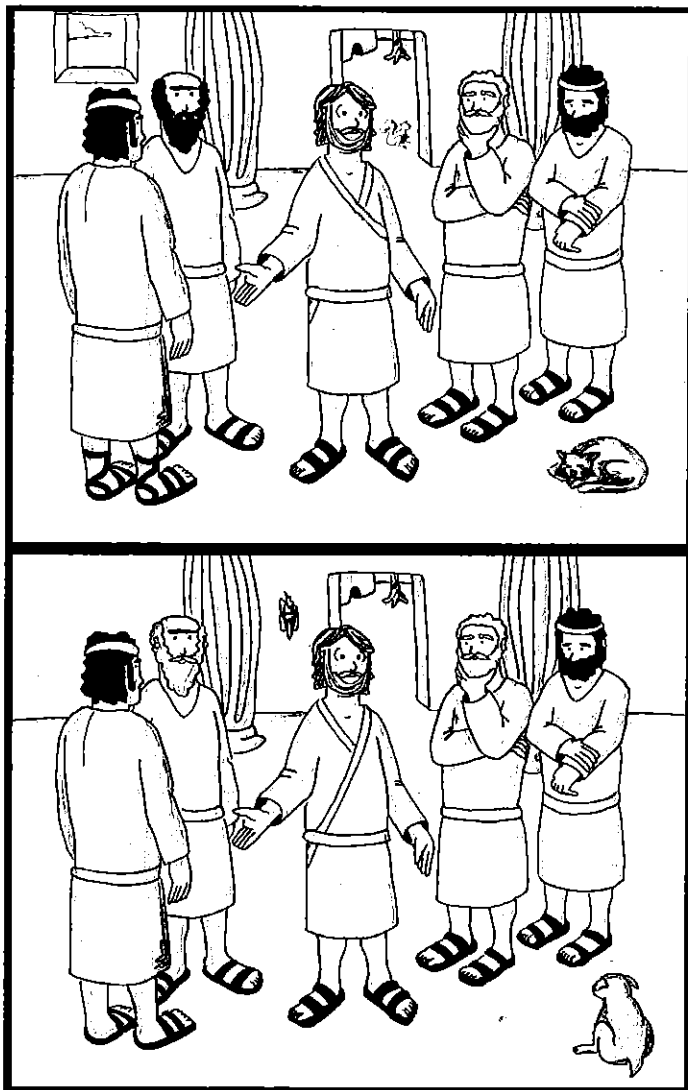
Jesus said, "I am the bread that came down
