Introduction: This morning, we will begin a new study where we focus on the life and times of Elijah.

- 1. Although he lived thousands of years ago, the times he lived in are very similar to our own.
- 2. Elijah came on the scene during the reign of Ahab and Jezebel in Northern Israel.
- 3. From the moment the North split from the South, a consistent spiritual decline was the norm.
- 4. Nineteen kings ruled in the north, not one of them respected or served God.
- 5. Each king was worse than his predecessor.
- 6. So, by the time Elijah emerges, Israel is as bad as she has ever been.
- 7. This is when God raises up Elijah to confront the evil of the day.
- 8. There is a principle here: God uses people.
- 9. The question we must answer: Am I willing to be used?
