Introduction: We have begun a study where we will focus on the life and times of Elijah.

- 1. Last week we considered the state of Israel when God raised him up as His prophet.
 - In doing so, we noted how very similar the times were to our own.
- 2. Today we consider the beginning of his ministry.
- 3. In light of Israel's sin under Ahab and Jezebel, Elijah pronounces a drought.
 - In other words, Israel is about to experience a season of suffering and Elijah would be seen as the cause.
- 4. This is a story about survival, but not an ordinary story.
- 5. This story supernaturally demonstrates how God really can "Give us each day our daily bread".
